

Shared Classes

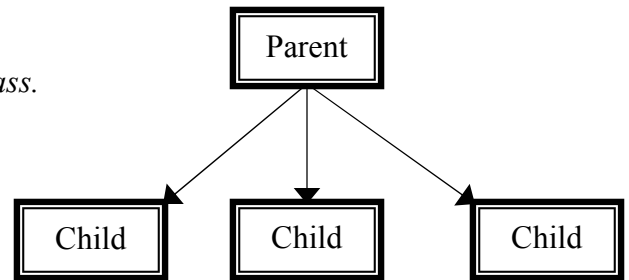
EDU allows for child classes to be made that inherit all question banks and assignments from the parent class.

Allowing others to create copies of your class:

- To allow others to create child classes from your class, from your instructor main menu, click **System Tools**.
- Click **“Share Class”**.
- Click the **“Shared”** radio button, and in the **“Registration Code”** box enter a password that other instructors will need to know to create a copy of your class.
- Click **OK**.

Now other instructors can create child copies of your class.

Creating Child Classes:



- Go to the class homepage of the parent class.
- Click **instructor login**.
Do not enter the instructor password into the box.
- Click on the folder icon in the lower left of the window that reads **“Register a copy of this class”**.
- Enter the password that the instructor has set for sharing. Click **Proceed**.
- Continue by entering all the necessary information into the fields.

Rules of Inheritance:

- The child class will inherit all the question banks and assignments of the parent class. If the parent class edits any of the assignments or question banks, those changes will be inherited by the child class.
- If the child class edits any assignment or question bank that was inherited from the parent class, the link for that assignment or question bank will be broken, and any future changes to that assignment or question bank will not be inherited.
- The child class will not inherit the grade book or roster of the parent class.
