

Barb Jacobson is the Director of Curriculum and Professional Development for the Lincoln Public Schools (LPS), a position she has held for six years. Barb, representing the public school system, is a co-principal investigator for the Math in Middle Institute Partnership. She began her teaching career as a fifth-grade teacher at Belmont School in the Lincoln (Nebraska) Public Schools where she taught for three years. She continued her teaching career at Hawthorne School and taught at several intermediate grade levels.
