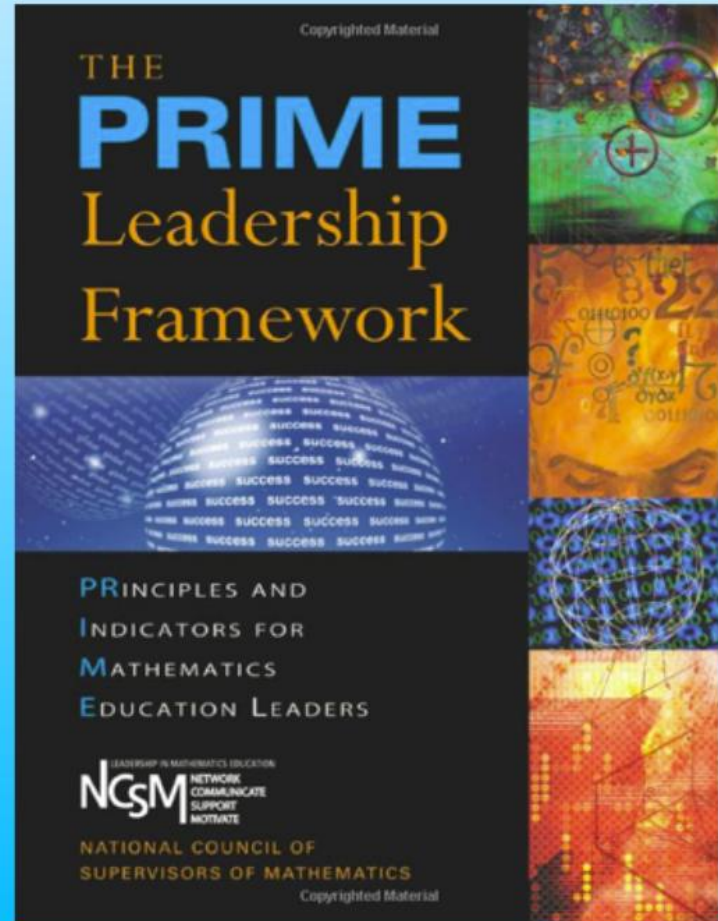

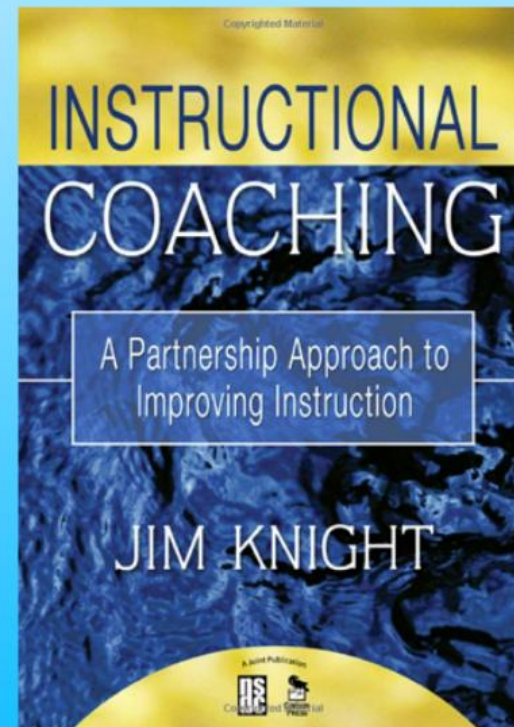
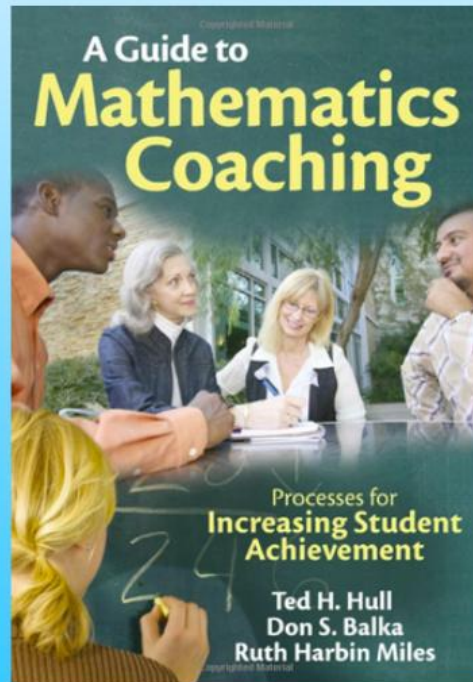
The PRIME Leadership Framework

I am **NOT** on an island by myself! I truly do belong to a team!"

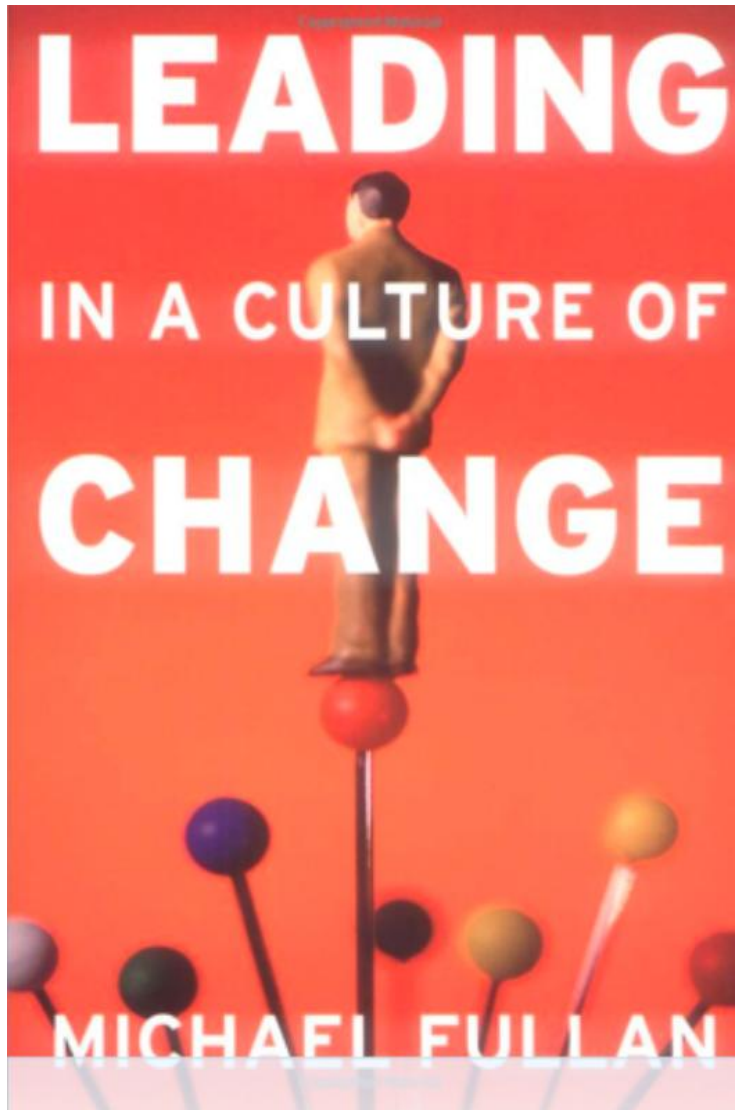
